COMPLY WITH LABELLING REGULATIONS AND LEAVE THE MARK OF A PROFESSIONAL

- **Identification**
Leave your work clearly and neatly labelled.
- **Connectivity**
Simplify the installation of cables by attaching a durable label to each end of the wire. This helps ensure connections are made correctly and minimises the time taken for troubleshooting and fault-finding if there are problems.
- **Maintenance**
Any follow-up visits for maintenance or testing are made easier thanks to clearly labelled faceplates, panels, cables and wires, conduits and machinery.
- **Hazards**
Ensuring hazards are identified and appropriate signage applied is critical.
- **Public Safety Information**
Print highly visible general warning signs. Yellow and orange can be used to warn of potential danger.

PROJECTS UNDERTAKEN

One of our most recent Medium Voltage installations occurred when a customer had a catastrophic breakdown whereby a transformer exploded, which this resulted in a fire, causing severe damage to the site's low voltage electrical equipment.

The existing electrical reticulation was in a poor condition, and did not provide the correct protection that is required on this specific site. The equipment was also installed in an area that contained hazardous processes that is integral to their processing of their product.

Our turnkey project consisted of the installation of:

New substations, removing the electrical equipment from the same area as the hazardous processes.

The installation of transformers with capacity to expand.

The installation of updated medium voltage switchgear, providing a high level of safety to both the operator and fault-free network operation.

New low voltage electrical reticulation system.

This has resulted in a safe, upgrade which is imperative to the electrical installation on the site.
